

Fall Soccer General Information 2016

Practices: Will be one day a week, the night and time depends on the coach and what they decide. You should hear from a coach by Labor Day or shortly after.

Games: Will always be Saturday mornings between 9-12pm we are usually all done by Noontime. Schedules will be passed out by the coach at your first practice.

Game Etiquette: Please do not stand by or behind your child's coach. Please do not stand on the sideline and coach your child. That is for the coach to do. Keep your cheering to positive and encouraging comments. Parents Must sit on the opposite side from the benches please...

Jerseys: Will be handed out at your child's first game. They are theirs to keep. They MUST be worn to every game or they cannot play. The jersey is mandatory!

Season: The season will start on Sept. 17th and go through October 29th , 2016

Coaches: We NEED COACHES so please help us out by coaching or assistant coaching. If we do not get enough coaches then your child could be on a team with a lot of other players and that means they will get less instruction, time on the field, etc. You do NOT have to be an award winning coach, just a parent willing to help out.....

Picture Day: Saturday, Sept. 24th, 2016 – your coach will know what time – TBD

Needs: Each player should have cleats and shin guards, even at the Micro Level so they do not get hurt and so they get used to wearing them.

Monday, August 1st 5:30-7pm at the NBCC

Cost: \$40.00 per player for a NB resident and \$50.00 per player for a non-resident.
\$95.00 for resident families of 3 or more.

LEAGUES:

Micro Leagues: Pre k, Kindergarten and any 1st graders (Parent must request to move up)

Minor Leagues: 2nd and 3rd graders. 1st graders who have played at least a year (parent must request)

Major Leagues: 4th, 5th, 6th graders and maybe some 3rd graders. (parent must request)

****MOVING YOUR CHILD UP A LEAGUE MUST BE REQUESTED BY THE PARENT!
And must be done BEFORE jerseys are ordered....**

PARENTS- IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT MOVING UP A LEAGUE

For some parents who want their 1st grader or 3rd grader to move up to the next league it **MUST be discussed at registration time.** This is not an automatic thing that happens, it must be brought up by the parents to the Rec. Director. Once discussed the Rec. Director will speak with last years coach and make the final determination and let you know. It is NOT the parent's decision. If a decision cannot be made that satisfies a parent than a refund will be given.
