

# General Summer Camp Information - 2016

(for more detailed info check out our Parents Handbook)

It is a six week program and the fee includes all six weeks of camp, field trip costs and a camp t-shirt. We do not offer part-time or just field trips. It is one fee for everything...

**Ages:** 5 years old (as of 1st day of camp and must meet eligibility requirements) to 13 y. o.

**Dates:** July 5th through August 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016

**Cost:** \$550.00 per child for a NB resident and \$600.00 per child for a non-resident.

Cost includes all six weeks of camp, all scheduled field trips and a camp t-shirt

**Deposit:** a \$25.00 non-refundable deposit is required for each child to hold their spot at camp

**Camp Hours:** 9am - 3pm

**Before and After Care:** Is available from 7-9am and 3-5pm for an additional \$4.00 an hour

**Lunch:** They bring it. We have no refrigerator or microwave available for them to use.

**Field Trips:** At least one a week, but typically two a week to places like Fun Town, Smitty's, Aquaboggan, Glo-Bowling, etc.

**Snack Shack:** Yes, we have a healthy, inexpensive concession stand

**Child/ Staff Ratio:** Depends on the age (example: Kindergarten would be like 5:1 where 6th graders might be like 10:1)

**Staffing:** All staff (junior counselors, paid counselors, leaders) are required to complete an employment application along with three letters of recommendation from non-family members. They each have at least one interview with the leadership team.  
They are all certified in first-aid and CPR.

**Camp Leaders:** We have two of them who have several years of teaching experience.

**Camp Director/ Rec. Director:** Has an on-site office and is present 95% of the time.

**First Aid/CPR:** All paid staff are certified in first aid and CPR.

## Registrations:

We will start taking registrations as of April 1st, 2016

The first 55 spots are guaranteed and then we go on a wait list until we reach 75 in order to justify the additional costs. Our maximum enrollment is 85.

**Sign-Up Dates:** Wednesday, April 6th from 5:30-7pm at NBCC  
Wednesday, May 25th from 5:30-7pm at NBCC

**Parent Information Night:** Friday, June 17th from 6-7pm at NBCC

It is **MANDATORY** for all first time campers and at least one parent/ guardian must attend with the camper.
