Dwayne explained that the capital improvements planned for this year include the following roads: **Beech Ridge Road** – Shim and Overlay from School House Road to lower end; **School House Road Road** – Shim and Overlay all; **Beech Ridge Road** Road – Shim and Overlay from Governor Goodwin Road to Noble High School entrance; **Boyle Road** – Shim and Overlay 4300 feet of Road from Route 4 towards bridge; **Randall Road** – Grind 1000feet of pavement and reconstruct and then Shim and Overlay to Corner;
